Join **FSD** and the **Make It Real Foundation** for a remarkable trip to Rajasthan, India from October 18 - 29, 2010. Participants will pool their donations together and engage in a collaborative grant decision-making process with several grassroots Indian community based organizations.



The impact of your donation is far reaching when you consider that even small amounts can transform the lives of many:

— \$1,000 brought 7 hand pumps and clean water to the village of Balvaria as well as 2 community workshops on conservation and hygiene.



— \$500 allowed 2 teachers to train 45 women micro-entrepreneurs in valuable financial literacy programs.

— \$500 established a library that benefits 600 students by improving their reading and education skills.

— \$275 funded 30 low-income women to participate in a 6 day long embroidery training camp resulting in self-employable skills.



Participants will observe the work of grantees first-hand, learning about the people they serve and the key challenges they face. The trip will promote a personal connection between donors and grantees, while advancing a more engaged grant decision-making approach.
